Noëlle Burgi, a political scientist and sociologist, is senior researcher at the French National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS), European Centre of Sociology and Political Science (CESSP), University Paris I-Panthéon Sorbonne. She was previously a visiting scholar at the European University Institute in the late 1980s, and a visiting scholar at the Center for European Studies at Harvard University in 1995. Her research centres on state transformation in Europe, neoliberal governmentality and the reconfiguration of the social state, the ‘new managerialism’ and its effects on working conditions and individual life trajectories and identity. She has done extensive fieldwork on unemployed and precarious workers. Her research focus in recent years has been on Southern Europe, notably on Greece where she has been engaged in the constitution of a scholarly network studying the social and political impacts of the austerity policies implemented since 2010. Currently she is heading a pluridisciplinary international research program on the port-city of Piraeus that aims to shed light on the transformation of Greece’s position in the world economy and the evolution of working and life conditions flowing from that.
